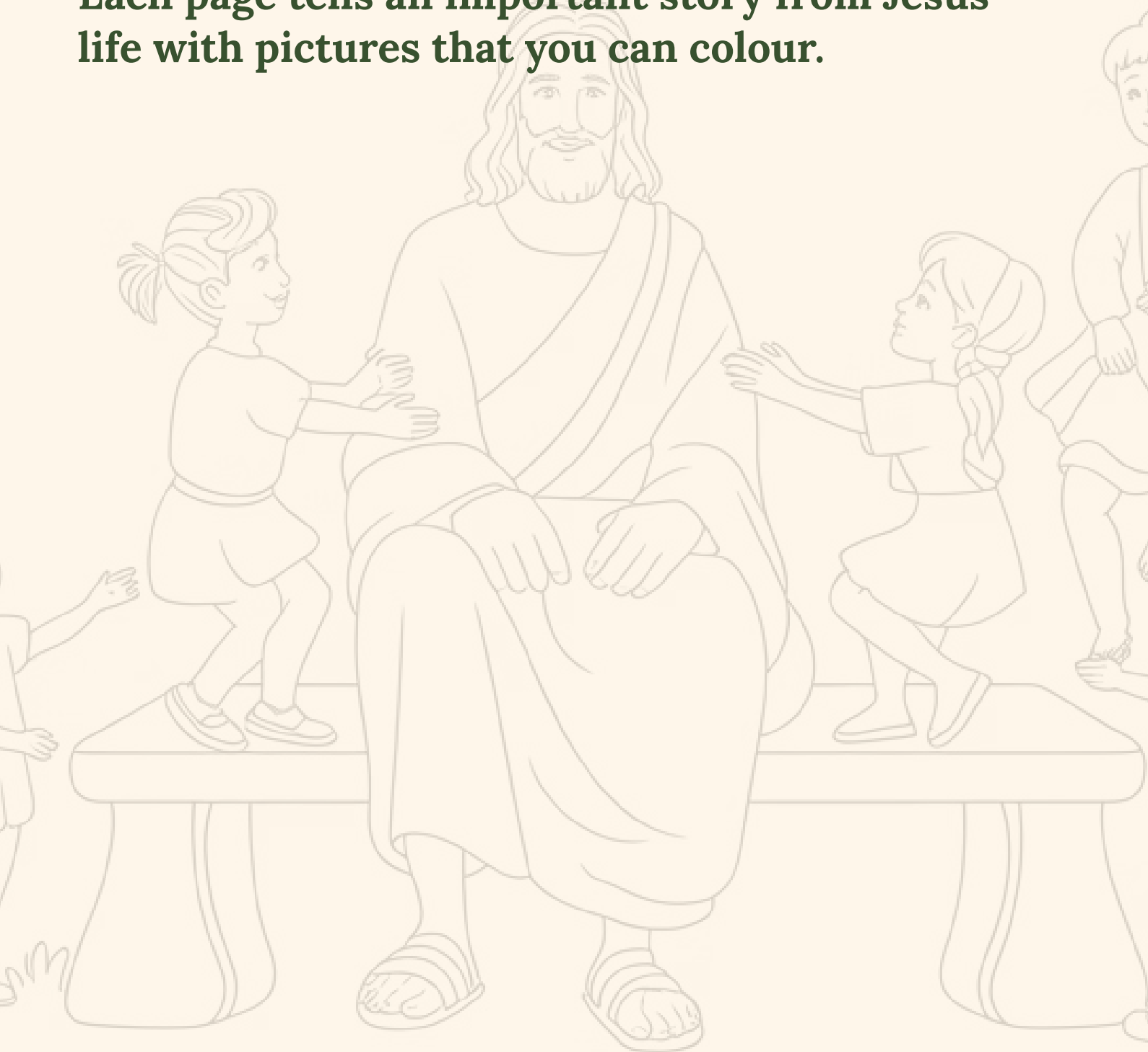


Colour The Life of Jesus

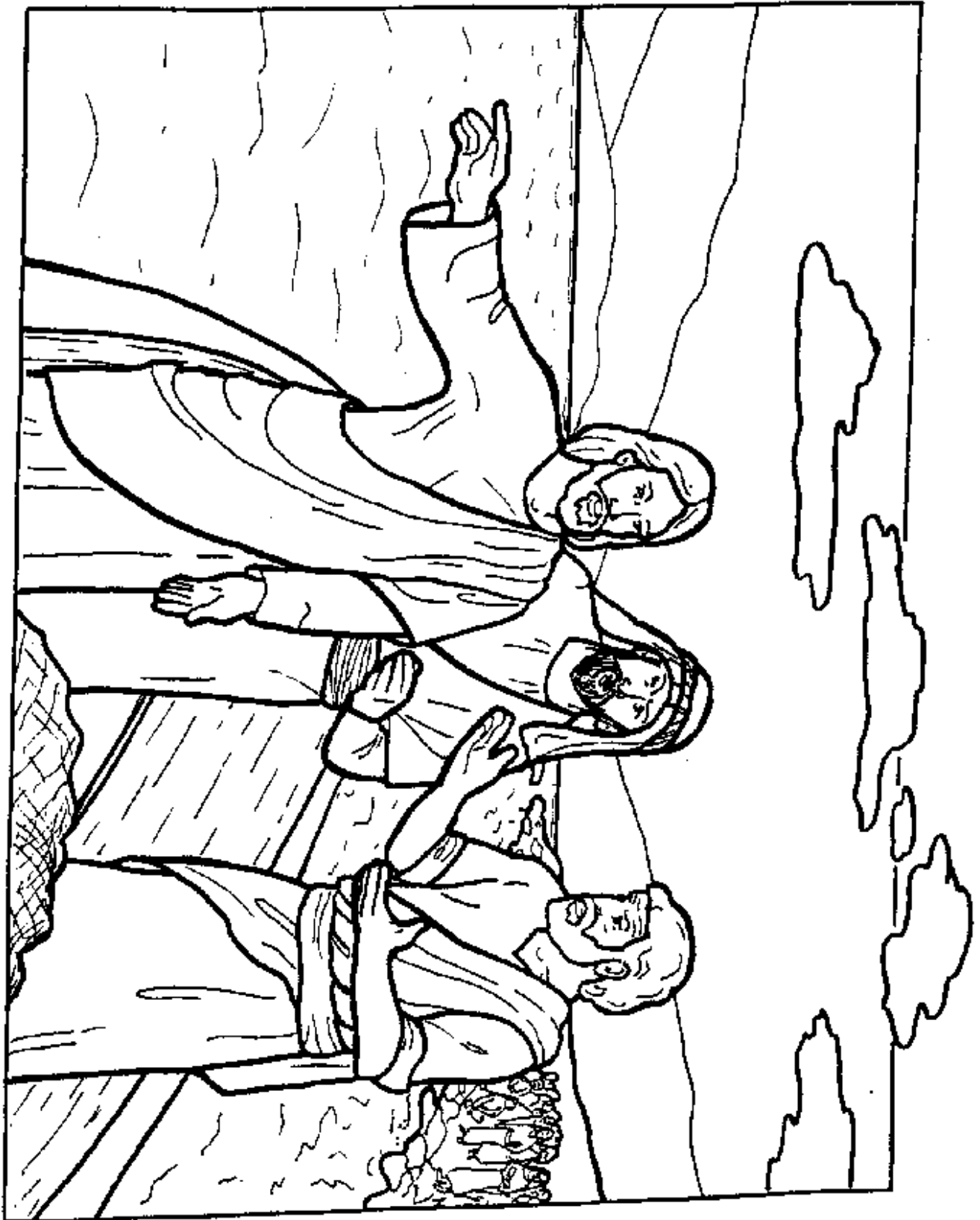
The sky opened up, and the Holy Spirit came down like a dove and rested on Jesus.

Jesus Calls His First Two Friends (Disciples)

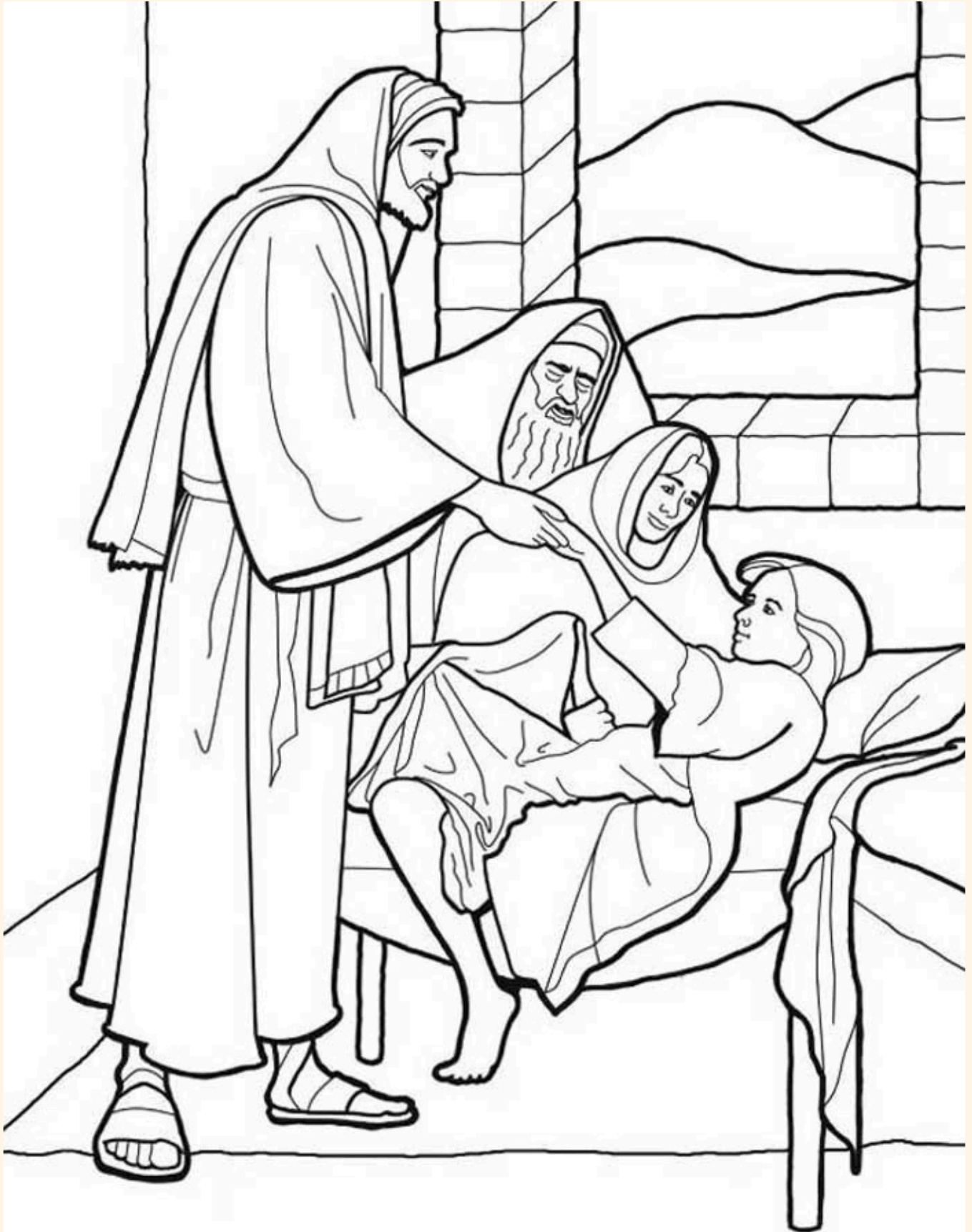
